Structure	The “Why”/Purpose
School Director Collaborative (SDC)	All School Directors; Once a month; BIG ROCK; Share successes and challenges; Check in on Design Principles; New focus each month in order to prepare for what’s to come ; Got a challenge? Let’s collaborate!
Leadership Connections	BIG Rock; A time for leaders to connect around the big ideas of leadership; cohort-based; Explore topics that help all of us grow and develop as leaders; Build capacity in others
Facilitator/Teacher Collaborative –	Facilitators from each “grade level” meet regularly with the director to discuss school challenges and create solutions.
Learner Collaboratives	Learners meet regularly with the director and/or designee to discuss ideas for improvement.
Parent Collaboratives	Regular meeting to involve parents in problem solving.
Other Collaboratives: Central Office collaborative, Leadership Residents Collaborative; Student Support (Special Ed. Team); Home Study; Office managers; PBL Team;Novare (LMS) Core Team; Math for Engagement Collab	Employees meet and share ideas and collaborate on projects, problems, initiatives, site- or program-specific aspects, that benefit our schools.
Parent University	Classes to support parents; Examples: Restorative Practices; 7 Habits, Love and Logic, Films, Guest
